The competition's challenging brief required the architects to consider a comprehensive and sensitive approach to placemaking on a university campus, as well as integration within the city of Kimberley in SA.

Our proposal wanted to create architecture for the people of Kimberley within a public realm and aimed to create a safe space for celebration. 


## RAISING NATURE
